PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOLS IN JORDAN

(Funded by a Grant from The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia through The Saudi Fund for Development)

- 1) The Short listed Saudi Consulting firms shall act in their own Capacity without associating with local firms since the Project Management scope will consists of:
 - Design Stage:
 Review of Designs of schools that will be prepared by local
 Consultants.
 - Construction Stage:
 Management and monitoring of overall performance at the School
 Construction sites for both local Contractors and local Supervision
 Consulting Firms.
- 2) The Successful bidder will be requested to submit details of his methodology for providing the services specified in the RFP in addition to the C.V's of the proposed staff for the review and approval of the Client prior to Contract signature, this will be considered a condition for Signing the Contract.
- 3) The Tender Security should be submitted by the Saudi Consultant since no joint venture with local companies are allowed as stated in bullet No. (1) above.

4) The number, size and location of Schools comprising the Project will be identified to the successful bidder. Nevertheless, Bidders shall price the Design Review scope based on a nominal area of 20,000 m² which will be will be re-measured according to actual area of Schools for which design is reviewed by the Saudi Consultants. This information should be sufficient at this stage for Saudi Consultants to price their efforts.

Scope will comprise new Schools and expansions to existing Schools.

- 5) Consultant scope is to manage multiple local supervision Consultants and Contractors working on different School locations.
- 6) The Project is exempted from all Taxes and duties including Stamp Duties.
- 7) Since the Schools' locations are not all identified at present no site visit or pre-bid conference will take place.
- 8) The Project is time based for Construction Management and area based for Design Review.
- 9) Jordanian Engineers with experience for at least five years in similar works in Saudi Arabia are considered to have international experience.

	 Corrected Tender Prices are arranged from the highest to the lowest. The median is selected, with two possible cases: a. In case of an odd number of tenderers, the middle position in sequence is selected as the median. b. In case of an even number of tenderers, the middle two positions in sequence are taken and the second of these two (the lowest) is selected as the median. Any tenderer whose tender Price is more or less than 30% of the median is excluded from the tender selection process. The mean (i.e., average) of the remaining Tender Prices is calculated by adding them and dividing the sum by their number. The Contract is awarded to the lowest Tender Price that falls within the 10% margin lower than the mean calculated in "4" above.
