The Ministry of Planning and International Cooperation (MoPIC) has been allocated grant funds (the “Grant”) from the Multi Donor Trust Fund (MDTF) by the World Bank (the “Bank”) and executed by the Ministry of Planning and International Cooperation (MoPIC) (“the Client”). The Client intends to apply the funds to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Proposals is issued. Payments by the Bank will be made only at the request of MoPIC and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the grant agreement. No party other than the Client shall derive any rights from the grant agreement or have any claims to the proceeds of the grant.
